Interim Statistics of 2022/23 Interview Candidates (MED 2027)

Qualified applicants received an academic file review, which included: review of English prerequisites, calculation of the overall average (OGPA), derived from all university-level transferrable courses and the removal, when applicable, of credits from the lowest academic year to give an adjusted academic average (AGPA).

The non-academic file review consisted of an evaluation of the extra-curricular activities (including awards, research and publications, where applicable) and employment history listed by applicants.

The outcomes of the academic and non-academic file review were equally weighted, and combined to generate a pre-interview result. Both the academic and non-academic scores were standardized against the current applicant pool.

British Columbia Applicants (BC)

Academic and non-academic file reviews were completed for **1396** applicants who were identified as BC residents. A total of **643** BC residents who achieved pre-interview results above the cutoff were invited to interview.

Out-of-Province Applicants (OOP)

Academic and non-academic file reviews were completed for **955** out-of-province applicants. A total of 97 OOP candidates who achieved pre-interview results above the cutoff were invited to interview.
